PHASE 1

This phase requires the applicant to provide:

- Contact Information
 - Email
 - Mailing Address
- Academics
 - GPA
 - ACT or SAT Scores along with an uploaded copy for validation. This may be a screenshot.
 - High School Transcript
 - This may be an official or unofficial copy
 - Club Activity
 - Beta events attended
 - Leadership roles and awards earned through Beta
 - Service hours completed (by project) and role during each.
 - Resume
 - Additional extracurriculars
 - Service hours (outside of Beta)
 - Awards/Honors (outside of Beta)



PHASE 2

Following a review of Phase 1 applications, all students selected to receive at least \$1,000 will be notified. The top 100 of these applicants will be asked to provide additional information as they move forward to the semifinalist round for the potential to receive one of our top 5 awards.

This phase requires the applicant to provide:

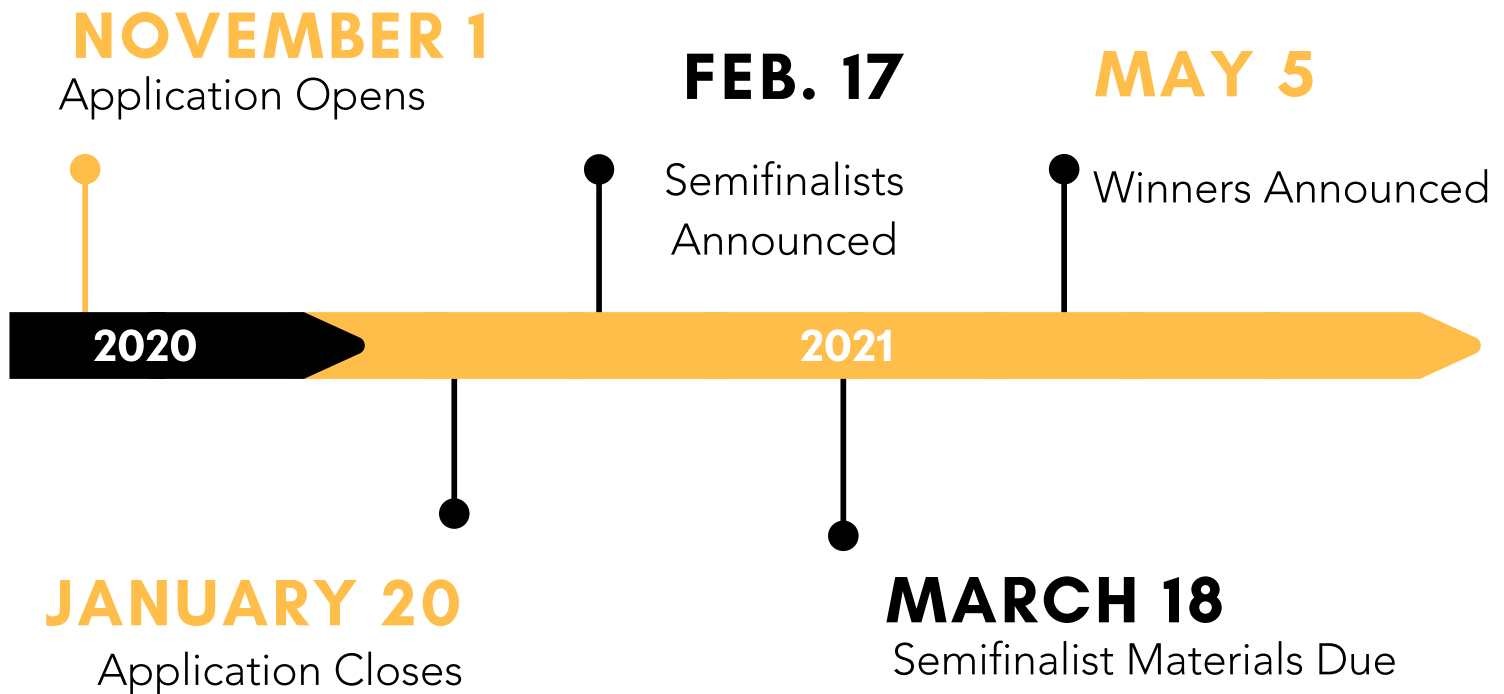
- 1 Sponsor Recommendation
 - Why is this student deserving of a National Beta Scholarship?
- 1-3 Candidate Evaluations
 - Assess character and leadership, as well as service activities and academic prowess
 - 2 Essays
 - Work History (if applicable)

HELPFUL TIPS

LOCATE MEMBER ID

In order to access the application, members will need to input their Member ID. Your ID can be found:

- On your Membership Card
- By asking your sponsor to check their Member Roster
- By calling the National Office 800-854-8281
- By emailing scholarship@betaclub.org with your name, school and state

CREATE A SUCCESS NOTEBOOK


Compile a success notebook throughout your high school career. Compiling this notebook will not only help in applying for a National Beta scholarship but for additional scholarships as well.

It should include:

- A record of service activities performed, approximate hours served and roles held within each.
- Awards/honors received
- Leadership positions held

PREPARE DOCUMENTATION

To apply for a scholarship, members must upload a copy of their ACT or SAT scores as well as a copy of their transcript.

- Scores and GPA entered must match the documentation uploaded.
 - Uploads may be scanned in or uploaded as a screenshot
 - No superscoring (combination of highest scores on different tests) is allowed.
 - Members must calculate and enter their unweighted GPA
