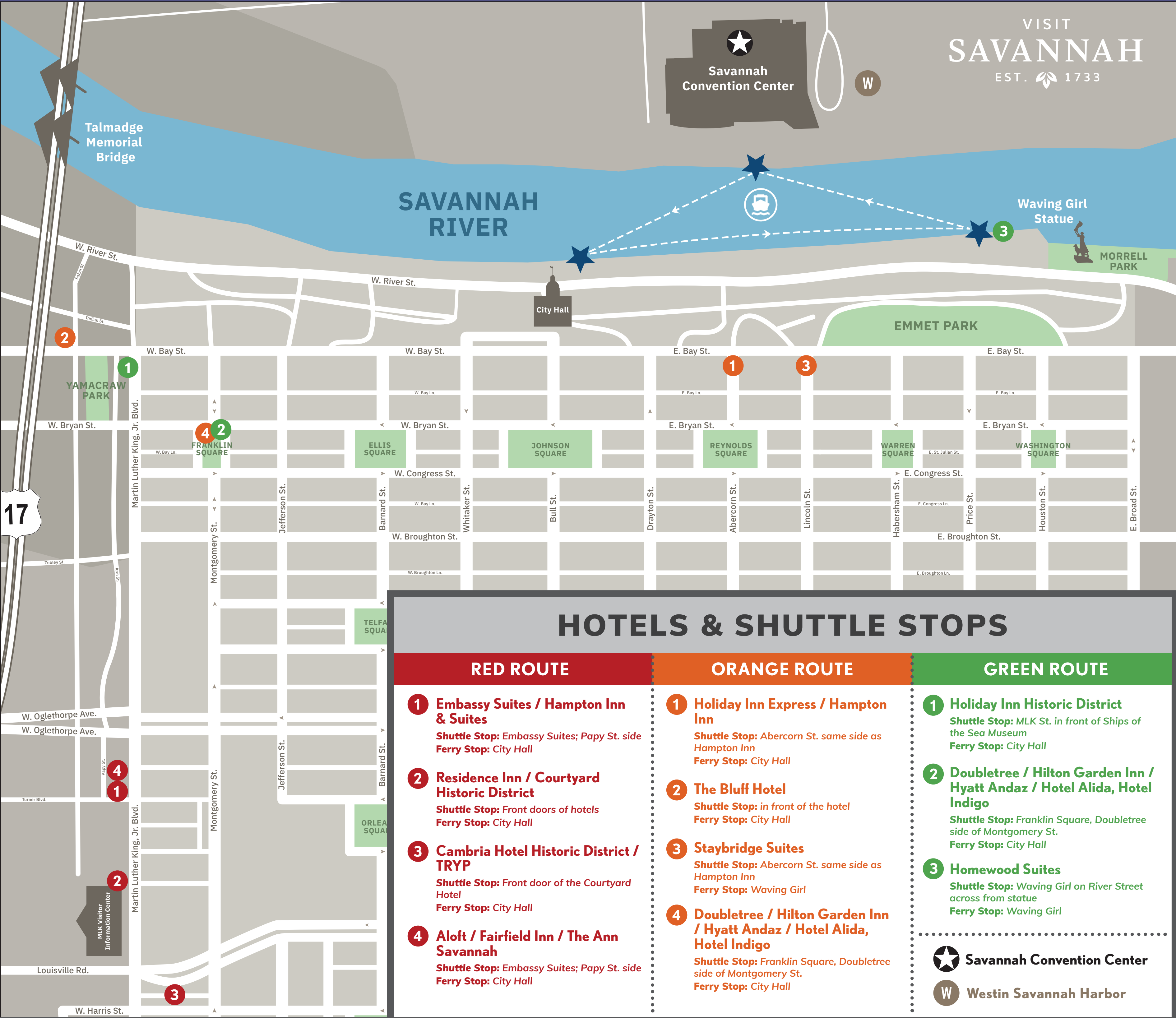




TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION



SHUTTLE SCHEDULE

Each route has been color coded to include conference hotels. Please look for your hotel's color when loading buses to/from the Savannah Convention Center. Shuttles will run a loop from historic Savannah to the Savannah Convention Center. Express loop every 15 minutes and Standard loop every 30 minutes.

FERRY SCHEDULE

Conference attendees can take advantage of the complimentary water ferry service that runs between the Savannah Convention Center, City Hall, and Waving Girl water ferry docks. Detailed hours are posted on each dock. The Express Schedule will run every 15 minutes, and the Standard Schedule will run every 30 minutes depending on which dock you are departing from.
